## Subject Coverage

### What is it?

**Ebook Central** (formerly **ebrary**) is a subscription database that provides access to over 9,000 ebooks in 18 subject areas of the humanities. Search the complete collection or within a single book. Create a personal Ebook Central account and you can bookmark and highlight passages, add notes, and have a personal bookshelf.

### How do I access it?

Go to the AAU Library homepage at [library.academyart.edu](http://library.academyart.edu). From there, you have two options.

- 1) Search for books using the Library's online catalog. When you find the book you like, click on the link in the grey box and you will be taken to the book on the Ebook Central website.
- 2) You can also search directly in Ebook Central. From the drop-down menus near the top of the homepage go to **Find Resources** then select **Online Resources**. Under **Full Text Electronic Books**, you can access the database by clicking on **Ebook Central**.

### How does this help me?

- Ability to download books to your laptop, tablet or phone (iOS and Android) for offline reading.
- Personal bookshelves that automatically store links to highlights, notes, and more, providing an archive of research. Folders can be emailed to peers.
- Multiple options for searching and navigating.
- Automatic citations when text is printed or copied and pasted into Word or any text applications.
- Compatibility with screen readers and other assistive technology for patrons with special accessibility needs.
- Catalog search and bookshelf interface available in multiple languages.

### What are the download options?

- You must create your own Ebook Central account in order to download, create a bookshelf, highlight, etc. You do this using the "Sign In" link on the upper right side of the website.
- You can download parts of each book as a PDF. Usually 30 or 60 pages at a time depending on publisher limitations. These PDFs do not expire.
- Many of the titles can be download in their entirety in the Adobe Digital Editions format. These expire in 7 or 14 days, depending on publisher limitations.
